Mexican Legends and Traditions

If you are spending Christmas in Mexico, Christmas activities begin with Las Posadas, nine consecutive days of candlelight processions and lively parties starting December 6th. In villages and urban neighborhoods throughout Mexico youngsters gather each afternoon to reenact the Holy family's quest for lodging in Bethlehem. The procession is headed by a diminutive Virgen Maria, often riding on a burro, led by an equally tiny San Jose. They're followed by other children portraying angels, the Santos Reyes (Three Kings), and a host of pastores y pastoras (shepherds and shepherdesses), all wearing colorful, handmade costumes.

The "Santos Peregrinos" (Holy Pilgrims) stops at a private house to request shelter for the night and sing behind the closed door which is repeated. At the second home where the scene is repeated. The door is opened and all are invited to enter to a feast of tamales, the smashing of the pinata and the eating of tamales, peanuts and candies.

RCIA: From Theory to Practice

This RCIA process has humble beginnings.

After long searching for catechetical models for our parish RCIA, I was fortunate to attend a workshop of the North American Forum on the Catechumenate in Los Gatos, California. Inspired by Father Jim Dunning, who spoke glowingly of the lectionary as the ideal basis for the RCIA process, I came back to my parish and modeled the next year's process on what seemed to me to be meaningful links between themes from the Sunday lectionary readings and areas appropriate for exploration in the four periods of the RCIA.

Meanwhile I continued to work out my own, doing what I was trying to do: model the RCIA process on the Sunday lectionary readings. Each spring I looked in publishers' catalogues for a finished catechetical work that followed these guidelines. Each summer, puzzled to find none, I sat down and continued to work out my own.

Since I had already been using *Catholic Update* as a catechetical tool with significant success, the decision to incorporate appropriate *Updates* into my evolving lectionary-based RCIA process was an obvious one. After three years of experimentation, and some prompting from friends, I sent samples of the process to St. Anthony Messenger Press, publisher of *Catholic Update*, who believed my efforts could be helpful to others also struggling to adapt a lectionary approach to their own parish situation.

'*Come and See*' takes the lectionary seriously. At the same time, however, it attempts to respect the four periods of the RCIA (pre-catechumenate, catechumenate, enlightenment and mystagoga). Scripture-Breaking themes, taken from the lectionary, are the wool that lend themselves to the warp—the Session themes—of RCIA.

B or C—depending on the calendar year. For example, an RCIA group that begins in the fall of 1987 will use the program for "Fall 1987—Spring 1988." Cycle A readings will form the basis of the program throughout the fall, and then Cycle B readings will come into play with the First Sunday of Advent. A similarly keyed packet of materials will be available for "Fall 1988—Spring 1989" and so on.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults was originally structured with Cycle A readings in mind for Lent, no matter the year. Therefore, alternate Cycle A Lenten materials are offered along with Cycle B or Cycle C for parishes that prefer to use Cycle A readings during Lent. These can be found at the end of both participant and leader packets.

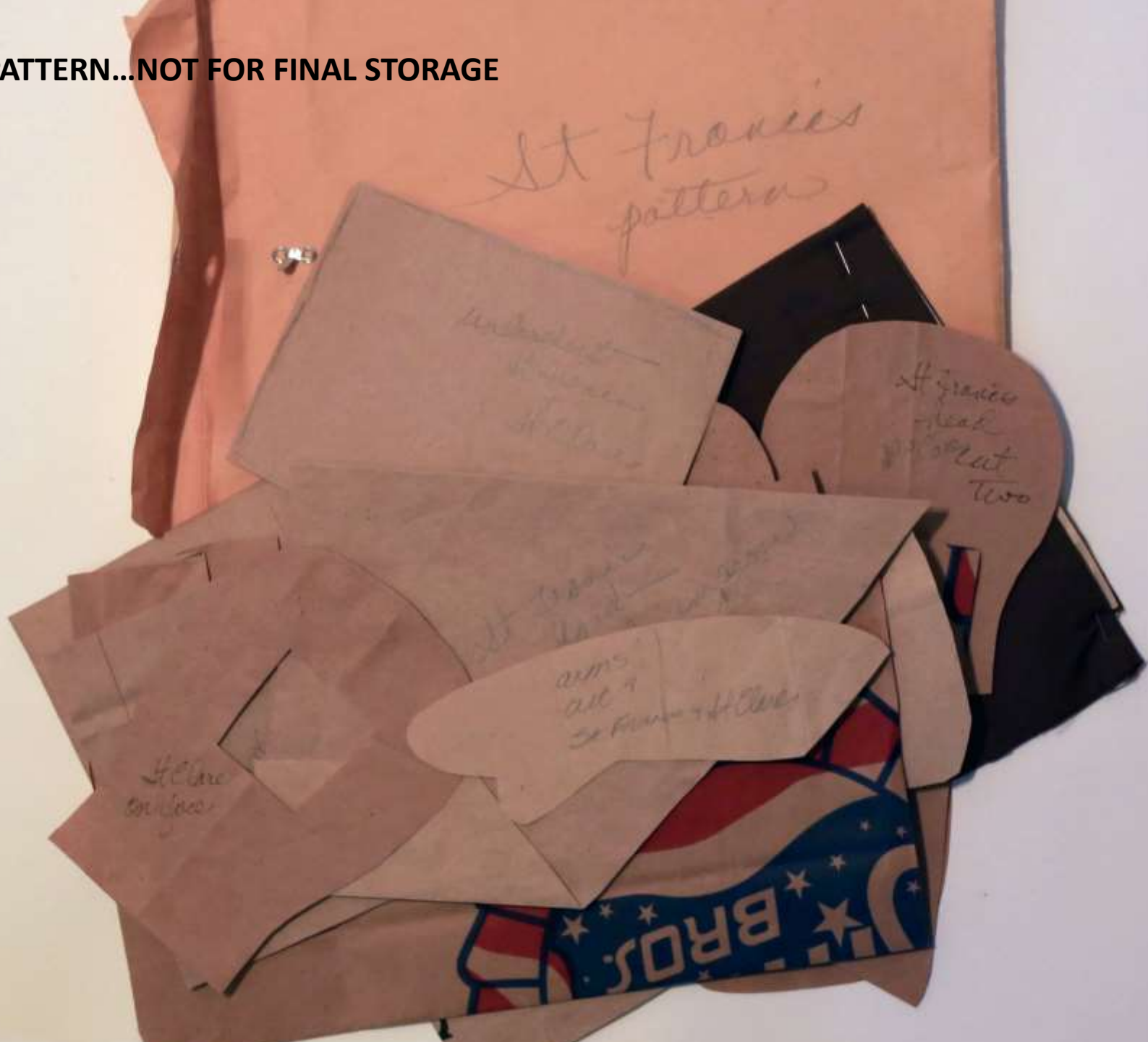

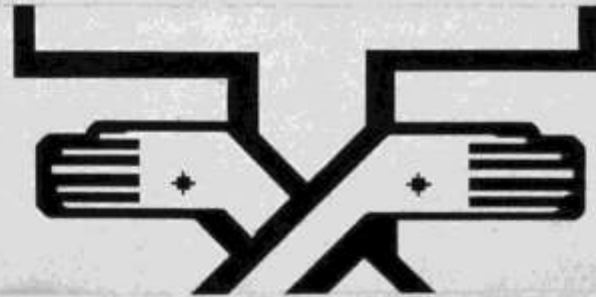

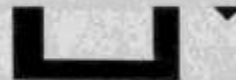
